



**CLARIFICATIONS IN RESPONSE TO QUERIES RAISED IN PRE BID MEETING HELD ON JUNE 29, 2017,
AT 10.30 AM IN NSFDC CONFERENCE ROOM**

	Issues raised	Proposed Response of D/o Social Justice & Empowerment
1.	Problems in obtaining acceptance letters from agencies for whom evaluation studies have been conducted by the Organisation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Executive summaries of 3 reports completed by the Organisation during the last 5 years may be uploaded along with acceptance letters from the sponsoring agencies. • In the event of non availability of acceptance letters from sponsoring agencies, copy of terms and conditions of the study that indicates that final instalment would be paid on acceptance of report by the sponsoring agency, along with proof that final instalment has been received by the Organisation may be submitted.
2.	Duration of study is too short	Will remain unchanged
3.	State-wise List of OAH/DCC/IRCAs	Uploaded for 2016-17. State wise list may please be seen at Ministry website: www.socialjustice.nic.in
4.	Whether an Organisation can form a Consortium & Bid	The Organisation may bid as a Consortium but the members of the Consortium would not be permitted to bid as individual entities also. The Lead Member/Organisation who would represent the Consortium for all future transactions with the Department in the event of acceptance of the bid may be identified upfront.
5.	Error in number of beneficiaries indicated.	The number of beneficiaries in OAH/DCC/IRCAs taken together during 2016-17 may be taken as 1,50,000 (approx)
6.	Coverage of the study	The study would be PAN India covering all states, OAH/DCCs/IRCAs
7.	Whether the sample size to be taken state-wise within the minimum 7% sample?	<p>De-addiction Centres</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State/UT-wise sample of beneficiaries may be taken. • Wherever number of centres is very less in a state or UT, all inmates may be covered for survey. • More beneficiaries may be covered in states with a greater presence of OAH/DCCs/IRCAs • In case of de-addiction centres, 7% beneficiaries may be appropriately distributed in the following manner: Inmates in the Centres – 4% Rehabilitated -3% Relapsed – 1% <p>Old Age Homes/Day Care Centres</p>

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State/UT-wise sample of beneficiaries may be taken. • Wherever number of centres is very less in a state or UT, all inmates may be covered for survey. • More beneficiaries may be covered in states with a greater presence of OAH/DCCs. • Family members/doctors/staff may be covered.
8.	Problem in uploading of financial bid	The financial bids in the indicated format may be scanned and uploaded. These would remain password protected and it would be possible to view them only on the date and time indicated after the short-listing of the technical bids.
9.	Whether NGOs can apply	No NGO can apply whether obtaining grant from the Centre/State Government or otherwise.
10.	Payment – Structure of Installments	The payment structure will remain unchanged
11.	Performance Guarantee fee is too high	Performance Guarantee may be taken as 8% of contract value as against 10% indicated in the Tender document.
